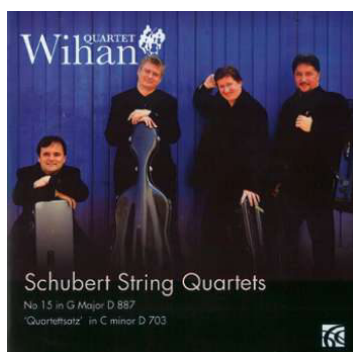


## Schubert: String Quartet in G major D887, Quartettsatz in C minor D703
